Major Responsibilities and Duties:

- 1. Works with individual students or small groups of students to reinforce learning of material on skills initially introduced by the teacher.
- 2. Assists the teacher in devising special strategies for reinforcing material or skills based on an understanding of individual students, their needs, their interests, and their abilities.
- 3. Operates and cares for equipment used in the classroom for instructional purposes.
- 4. Helps students master equipment or instructional materials assigned by teacher.
- 5. Distributes and collects workbooks, paper and other materials for instruction.
- 6. Guides independent study, enrichment work, and remedial work set up and assigned by the teacher.
- 7. Assists with the supervision of students during emergency drills, assemblies, play periods, and field trips.
- 8. Alerts the appropriate personnel to any problem or special information about an individual student.
- 9. Maintains the same high level of ethical behavior and confidentiality of information about students as is expected of a fully licensed teacher.
- 10. Upholds and adheres to safety rules and policies of the SISD safety program.
- 11. Supports the goals and objectives of the school district and follows all district policies.
- 12. Demonstrates the ability to attend work on a regular and routine basis to avoid disruption to district operation.
- 13. Performs any other duties as assigned by the appropriate supervisor.
- 14. Provides optimal customer service to all students, employees, parents, community, members and any other stakeholders of the district.
